



**Launched by the European Commission's Directorate General for Regional Policy, the "Europe in My Region Photo Competition" aims to highlight the work that projects across Europe are doing with the help of EU funding, and explore the meaning of these projects to local communities.**

Any permanent EU resident or resident of a pre-accession country ([Albania](#), [Bosnia and Herzegovina](#), [the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia](#), Kosovo, [Montenegro](#), [Serbia](#), and [Turkey](#)), is invited to apply.

Participants need to be over 18 years old. They can submit as many pairs of pictures as they wish: the first one portraying the project and the second one showing the information board about the EU funding (billboard, plaque, EU flag, etc).

30 winners will be selected by a jury comprised of three photography or social media experts.

Voting begins on the 23 April and ends on the 31st August. There is no limit of votes per person.

The 30 selected photographs will be part of a photo exhibition that will travel across Europe and will receive publicity via the European Commission's channels (website, social media).
